

reflection

Don begins our new series looking at the book of Exodus and the life of Moses.

This week, we are introduced to the 'God of Exodus', the God who sets people free. We live in a world where people are bound by addiction and challenges and it affects us today just as much as it affected the children of Israel.

We're going to study how God sets us free then uses us to be instruments of freedom to other people.

debrief

Ask a few questions about the last week's Practice:

- Any stories from the past week you would like to share to encourage the whole group?
- Any "aha" moments of breakthrough?
- Any highs or lows?

discussion

- 1. What is/are your favourite confectionery?
- 2. Do you agree with Professor Art Glasser's comment that, 'addictions are the dominant form that possessive and destructive evil has taken in our culture?'
- 3. What do you think about the statement, 'addiction is ultimately a disorder of worship?'
- 4. Is there merit in seeing addiction through the 'disease lens' rather than the 'sin lens'?
- 5. Which end of the spectrum do you find yourself leaning when it comes to Divine Sovereignty and Human Responsibility?

practice

- 1. This week, ask Jesus to continue to break off lies that are holding us back, to reveal negative spiritual strongholds that we may not be aware of, and to give us the strength and discipline to put into place any changes we need to make in our lives, as revealed by the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Check in with a friend or family member who you know is walking through addiction of any kind, or continues on the journey of healing and restoration. Encourage and build them up, remind them that God has not forgotten, that He will not forsake them and if appropriate, offer to pray with them.
